You will be met by a nurse and accompanied to the *Cardiac Investigation Unit (CIU)* where you will be for the duration of your stay. CIU is an open plan ward especially designed to maintain a high level of safety and observation of patients. The direct telephone number for CIU is +64 9 623 5752 for use on day of procedure.

PREPARATION

Please have nothing to eat or drink from midnight before your admission.

WHAT TO BRING

An overnight bag, all your medications, blood test results if they are available to you



MEDICATION

If you take Warfarin, or other heart rhythm medication this will need to be stopped several days before the procedure. Your cardiologist will inform you if this.

Other routine medications should be taken with little water except for diuretics, as listed below, which are to be omitted if your procedure is at 11am or earlier.

Lasix (Frusemide)	Moduretic	Bendrofluazide
Neo-nalex	Aldactone	Dyazide
Navidrex	Aprinox	Amiloride

If you are diabetic or have any allergies, please inform us at the time of booking.

DURATION OF YOUR STAY AND DRIVING

Usually this is a day case, but sometimes you may need to stay overnight.

You are advised not to travel out of Auckland on the day of the procedure. And to have someone stay with you overnight if you are discharged the same day. *You will need to be driven home and should not drive for the remainder of the day.* If you require accommodation near the hospital, the staff at Mercy Angiography will be able to assist you.
